LDCSA & KSSP Affiliations & Competitions	KSSP: £900 LDCSA: £35	Subscription for sports competitions and events across Knowsley and Liverpool	Children participated in more Level 2 Competitions. Children have taken part in a range of competitions in both Knowsley and Liverpool: Athletics, Boccia, Cross Country, Football (Halewood Primary Football League and Liverpool FC Schools Tournament), Kurling, High 5 Netball, and Swimming. An increased number of children entered into sports teams. The new sports of Boccia and Kurling provided opportunities for more children to develop skills in a range of sports and gain a secure knowledge and understanding of the role of fair play and sportsmanship.
Playground	Play leaders training: N/A	Training for playground leaders using the equipment and resources purchased	Children in year 5 and 6 received training from KSSP on how to be an effective playground leader and promote activity on the yard. The young leaders have become responsible for the running of various activities. It also allows the play leaders to develop their leadership skills during their 'Play Leader' roles.
Dance and Boccia Extra Curricular Club	£60 x 10 week block £600 in total	Dance and Boccia club for all year groups in term 1.	In Term 1, children had the opportunity to attend Dance Club of Boccia Club. Children had the opportunity to develop a dance across a 10 week period, and learn a new sport of Boccia. Children developed their skills and confidence and thoroughly enjoyed the clubs.
Judo Extra Curricular Club	£500	Early Morning Judo club taught by specialist instructor	In Term 1, children from KS2 had the opportunity to take part in Judo club. This allowed them to learn new skills and disciplines in a different sport.
Sports Providers	£3872	High quality PE lessons and after school clubs.	Lessons delivered to KS2 classes throughout the year to encourage greater sports participation and skill development. This was also an opportunity to provide CPD to teachers and TA's. KS1 received coaching in Multi-Skills after school club which enhanced their understanding of basic skills from throwing and catching, to running and jumping. KS2 received coaching in Football and Basketball. This allowed them to develop their understanding of specific sports.
