Learning Objectives

To speak in sentences using familiar vocabulary using the numbers 1,000, 2,000 and the current year

To broaden their vocabulary using nouns for fruits and vegetables

To understand basic grammar appropriate to the language being studied including the masculine and feminine forms for nouns.

To engage in conversations, ask and answer questions; express opinions and respond to those of others through recalling and using numbers between 0 and 50 and asking for quantities of fruit and vegetables.

To listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding through a simple shopping dialogue at the market.

To present ideas and information through taking part in a class survey about fruit and vegetable preferences.

To read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple writing show by using some simple recipe instructions.
