EYFS Statutory Educational Programme:

'Children's personal, social and emotional development (PSED) is crucial for children to lead healthy and happy lives, and is fundamental to their cognitive development. Underpinning their personal development are the important attachments that shape their social world'.

3 and 4-year-olds will be learning to:

- Become more outgoing with unfamiliar people, in the safe context of their setting. Develop appropriate ways of being assertive.
- Show more confidence in new social situations.
- Talk about their feelings using words like 'happy', 'sad', 'angry' or 'worried'.
- Understand gradually how others might be feeling.

Children in Reception will be learning to:
