How can we use technology to communicate? How should we communicate when using technology? Can you communicate positively? Reflect, evaluate and Feedback?	To find the pulse when listening to a song and understand that it is the heartbeat of the music To recognise and name two or more instruments in a piece of music e.g. male vocal, bass guitar, drums, decks To march in time with the pulse To copy back rhythms To rap and sing in time to music To improvise using C as part of a performance To compose a simple melody using simple rhythms (C & D). To play instrumental parts accurately and in time as part of a performance. To perform and share the song.	Perform a variety of skills, keeping a ball under control. To bounce, roll and carry a ball. Throw a ball in different ways (high, fast, slow). Master basic throwing technique to throw and catch with others. Catch with increasing control and accuracy. Apply ball skills in small sided games. To move towards a goal to defend it.	To be able to perform 5 key shapes. To perform a range of actions with control and co-ordination. Form simple sequences of different actions, using the floor and a variety of apparatus. To balance using different parts of the body.
