Key a small description of the symbols used on a map

Ordnance Survey a map which shows all physical and human geography in an area

Scale refers to the relationship between distance on a map and the corresponding distance on the ground.

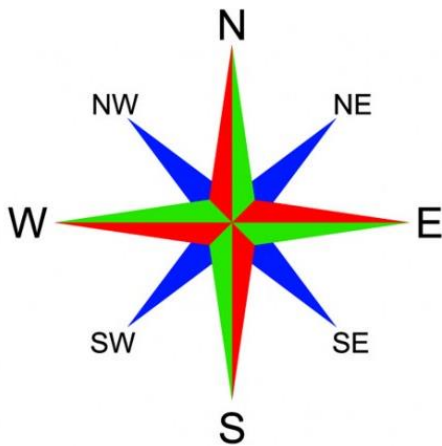
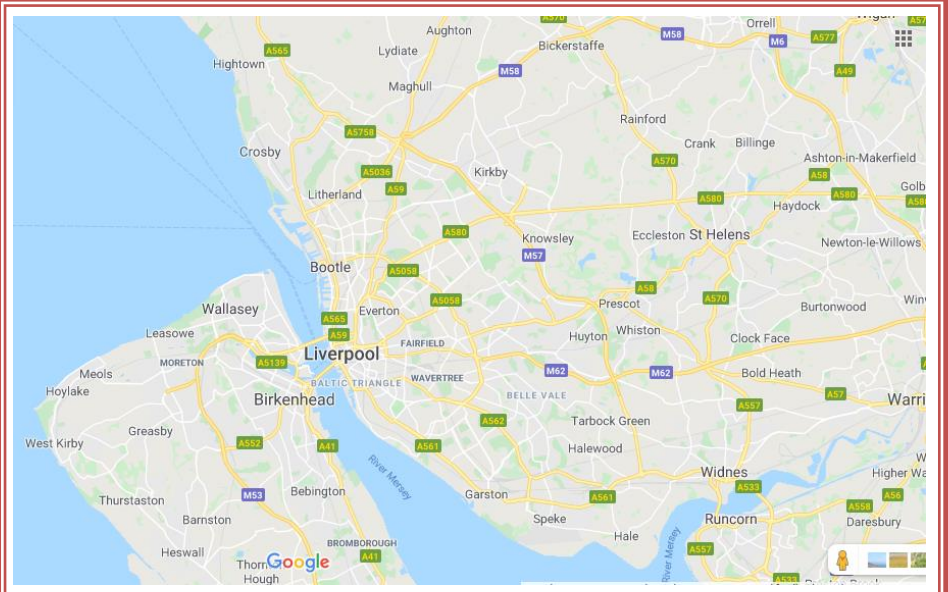
Region A region is a specific area that has common features
