## **Personal Development Ground Rules**

Here at Holy Family, all pupils and staff will always act appropriately and follow the following rules in every Personal Development lesson:

- **4** Everyone will show respect in all lessons, both in their actions and words
- Everyone will understand that there is no such thing as a silly question; we are all lifelong learners at Holy Family
- For any question that you don't feel comfortable asking in front of others, a box is provided in the classroom for such times. Your teacher cannot guarantee they will answer it straight away, but they will definitely answer it. You must always put your name on it. By putting your name on, staff can keep you safe and make sure your teacher knows who to address the answer to
- When discussing an issue during a lesson, it is ok to share examples of experiences but it is <u>not</u> ok to include names. If people would like to share stories we can learn from, pronouns such as 'someone' or 'a child', or 'a family' should only be used
- Anything that has been told to you in confidence by a friend or family member, or 'gossip' should never be shared with the rest of the class
- If you are concerned about yourself or a friend, you can share this in confidence with your teacher or TA. They promise never to share what you tell them with the rest of the class. However, they cannot promise not to share it with another trusted adult in the school, such as Mr Quigley, Miss Barr, Mrs Davey, Mrs Reeves or Mrs Powell. They will do this if they feel that you need more help.
