To understand basic grammar including the conjugation of high-frequency verbs by recognising and using parts of the verb to play in the present tense.

To express a like or a dislike and my opinion about a sport.

To engage in conversations to express simple opinions about sports.

To present ideas and information orally by describing simply a sport.
