- How to support each other's mental health by expressing feelings.

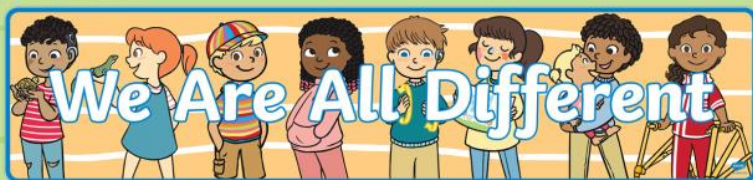
