Deuteronomy 6: 4-9 Ten Commandments; *These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts.*

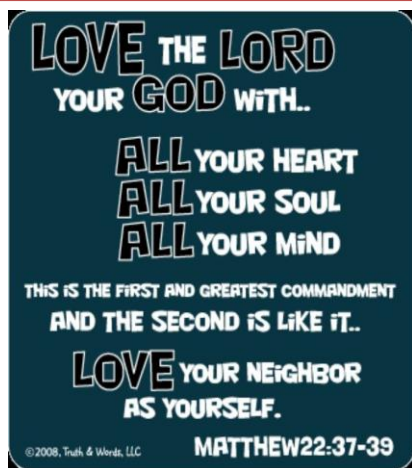
