Year 3/4 Spanish Celebrating Carnival and Body Parts



In this sequence of lesson, we will use language skills to:

- Listen to and join in with songs and games to explore nouns and adjectives (beginning to explore agreement spelling)
- Consolidate knowledge of nouns in Spanish gender and use of singular and plural nouns.
- Develop listening, speaking, reading and writing skills.
- Revisit, develop and extend understanding of simple use of nouns in singular and plural and be more aware of gender of nouns.
- Begin to explore how to build simple sentences using nouns, verbs and adjectives.

Learning Objectives

To explore the patterns and sounds of language through songs and rhymes and link the spelling, sound and meaning of words with a game of charades about animals and fancy dress.

To read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple writing by following a sequence of movement commands and body parts to make a physical puppet.

To read, identify and use nouns of body parts.

To read and build sentences using basic grammar rules with adjectives and nouns to describe an alien's or monster's body.

To listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding by responding to an Easter Egg hunt story.
