**Year 3/4 Spanish**  
**Feeling Unwell and Jungle Animals**



In this sequence of lessons, we will use our language skills to:

- Understand Spanish grammar rules including masculine and feminine nouns, and adjectives to describe nouns;
- Develop reading aloud and performing a story;
- Experiment with writing simple sentences;
- Perform confidently a story about a jungle.

**Learning Objectives**

To develop accurate pronunciation and intonation using some familiar nouns for parts of the body and the face in Spanish.

To engage in conversations; asking and answering questions to tell someone some simple phrases to explain why I don't feel well.

To broaden vocabulary by remembering the nouns for some jungle animals in Spanish.

To appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes in the language by listening to, joining in and understanding a story rhyme about a walk in the jungle and the animals we see.

To build and write a simple descriptive sentence about a jungle animal.

To present ideas and information orally taking part in a spoken performance of a story rhyme about a walk in the jungle.
