**Queen Elizabeth I**  
 Born 07.09.1533  
 Queen of England  
 1558 – 1603  
 Reigned for 45 years  
 She had no children  
 She was the last Tudor  
 Monarch  
 Succeeded by James  
 1(VI) of Scotland



**Queen Victoria**  
 Born 24.05.1819  
 Queen of UK 1837 – 1901  
 Additional Title  
 Empress of India - 1876  
 Reigned for 63 years  
 She had 9 children  
 Succeeded by her son  
 Albert – King Edward VII



**Queen Elizabeth II**  
 Born 21.04.1926  
 Queen of UK 1952 – present  
 Britain's longest reigning  
 monarch  
 She is the oldest monarch  
 in the World.  
 She has 4 children

<b>Monarch</b>	King or Queen
<b>Monarchy</b>	King or Queen is Head of State
<b>Tudor Period</b>	The Tudor period is the period between 1485 and 1603 in England and Wales and includes the Elizabethan period during the reign of Elizabeth I until 1603.
<b>Stuarts Period</b>	The Stuart period of British history lasted from 1603 to 1714 during the dynasty of the House of Stuart.
<b>Victorian Period</b>	<b>Victorian era.</b> In the history of the United Kingdom, the Victorian era was the period of Queen Victoria's reign, from 20 June 1837 until her death on 22 January 1901.
<b>Significant</b>	Someone who is important to others
<b>Buckingham Palace</b>	Is the official London residence for the UK's Monarch. Victoria was the first monarch to live at Buckingham Palace in 1837, when she made it her home.
<b>Commonwealth</b>	Is a group of countries whose Monarch is Queen Elizabeth II
<b>Jubilee</b>	The celebration of certain anniversaries, 25 <sup>th</sup> – Silver Jubilee, 50 <sup>th</sup> – Golden Jubilee.

### Famous Queens - Facts

<b>Tudors 1485 – 1603</b> Queen Elizabeth 1 1558 - 1603	<b>Queen Victoria 1837 - 1901</b>	<b>Queen Elizabeth II 1952 - Present</b>
Daughter of Henry VIII and Ann Boleyn She was Queen for 45 years. Elizabeth I was the last Tudor Monarch. Elizabeth's reign was a time of great exploration. She was succeeded by James 1(VI of Scotland)	Became Queen at the age of 18. 1840 – married Albert of Saxe-Coburg- Gotha. She had 9 children. Ruled for over 60 years. Queen of the British Empire.	Became Queen at the age of 27. Her Father was King George VI Married Prince Philip of Greece and Denmark in 1947. She has 4 children. She is the longest serving British Monarch in history.
