- Discovered the tomb of Tutankhamun with Lord Carnaryon in 1922

Tutankhamun lived around 1342 to 1324 B.C.

Tutankhamun was known as the Boy King

Tutankhamun was Pharaoh for 10 years until his death at the age of 19

Howard Carter found Tutankhamun's tomb in 1922.
