To celebrate ways of meeting God in our communities.

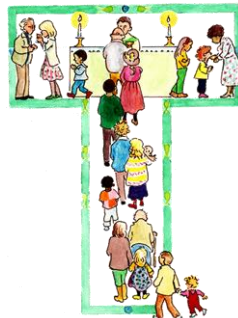
