

Key Vocabulary:

Minibeast – A small invertebrate animal like an insect or spider

Invertebrate – An animal or insect with **NO** backbone

Features – part of a minibeast e.g. legs

Habitat / Environment – The home or environment of a minibeast

Categorise – To put in a group

Life Cycle – The different stages of life for a living thing, usually shown as a circle

Suited – Right for that group

Types of habitats:



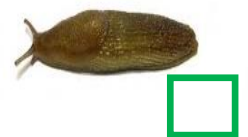
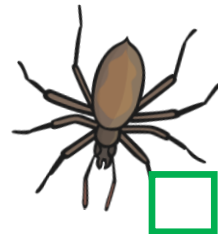
