

FREE SCHOOL MEAL VOUCHERS

Knowsley Council are once again using the Council's Household Support Fund grant to purchase vouchers for children eligible for means tested free school meals pupils for all the school holidays up to and including Easter 2024. For the October half term, the vouchers will be emailed and go out on Wednesday 25th October. The voucher total will be £15.

If you think you may be entitled to free school meals, please call into the school office and complete an application form for Mrs. Wall to send off to Knowsley Council to check your eligibility. We would hate to hear that a family is missing out on this additional funding so please let us know and we can check for you.
