Year 5

Year 5 is an opportunity to embed all of the knowledge learnt in lower Key Stage 2. It is expected all the foundations of learning are now well embedded and children are supported to apply their knowledge in creative and increasingly complex ways.

Like all year groups, Year 5 has a set of age related expectations. Even though there are no standard tests in Year 5, the children will be assessed throughout the year to see if they have reached these standards. All children are helped in order to achieve this and are given extra support and guidance if needed.

Year 5- Maths

• Year 5 is an important year in the maths curriculum, as your child will be securing all the skills needed to access the SATs at the end of Year 6. Children are expected to know and confidently use all the addition, subtraction, multiplication and division methods. The children will be encouraged to use their understanding of the new concepts to solve challenges to deepen their understanding. There is also an emphasis on fractions, decimals and percentages in Year 5.

Year 5- English

- Your child should now be confident applying a range
 of spelling patterns, punctuation and grammatical techniques.
 New punctuation includes hyphens, semi-colons and colons.
 There is a greater emphasis on grammar features too, such as model verbs (would, could, must). Your child will continue to write a variety of different genres.
- As fluent, confident readers, children in Year 5 are expected to read widely and independently. The teaching of comprehension will be a mixture of oral and written tasks, building upon the skills they have learnt earlier in the school, such as prediction, inference and summarising key points. Their answers will need to be specific, referring back to the with Christ at the centre, we live, love and learn together, reaching out to all.



Additional support:

There may be times when we feel that some children may need additional support. This could be children who are struggling with something in particular, or children who may be high achievers who we want to boost further.

This could be:

- Daily reading support
- Daily pre-planned interventions
- Ad-hoc support 1:1 or small groups



Homework

Reading

Reading records need to be in daily and children are expected to read most nights. This can be a Reading Plus lesson or a book of their choice.

If children do not hand in their reading record in regularly across the week, then they will read for five minutes at the beginning of their lunch break.

As part of the nightly reading, at least two lessons of Reading Plus must be completed at home across the week so that children can achieve the target of 5 lessons per week.

Opportunities are given to access Reading Plus during the school day too.



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Homework

Spelling

Each week, on a Monday, your child will be given spellings in their homework books and a task to complete. This is usually based on our current English book.

Tests will be carried out the following Monday.

Homework Books can remain at home until a Monday.
