

APPLYING FOR A CATHOLIC PLACE

Just a reminder that in addition to applying to the local authority for a school place in September 2024, if you are applying for a Catholic place within the admissions policy then you must also complete a supplementary faith form and return this in person to the school office by the 15th January 2024. One of the key points being made is that your child must be baptised ahead of the closing date, 15th January rather than the starting date in September 2024.

ASPIRE DAY TWO

This week, all pupils across the school have taken part in our second Aspire Day of the year.

Over the academic year, our EYFS children study the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph who, as a Catholic community, are the first people we aspire to. For this term, their focal person is Jesus.

In Key Stage One, they study a variety of jobs that are crucial to a successful society. Year 1 have looked at dancers. Year 1/2 have explored the job of a supermarket worker and Year 2 have studied the role of a police officer.

In Key Stage Two, each class have studied an inspirational British campaigner. Between the classes, they have explored the lives of; Elizabeth Prout, Monsignor James Nugent, Dr Mya Rose Craig, Emmeline Pankhurst, and Baroness Doreen Lawrence Our Aspire work always creates great discussion and debate with our children.
