

LIFE-VAC DONATION TO SCHOOL

It was a pleasure to catch up with the family of Sophia (Reception class) who have purchased and donated a new Life-Vac device for our school. Sophia's aunt and uncle met with children and Mr Quigley yesterday afternoon. Sadly, they lost their son, Marty, last year tragically at the age of 26, due to him choking whilst out eating with his family and emergency services were unable to save him. Marty was a past pupil at Halewood Academy. Marty's mum, Clare Weir, has been working with a company called Life-Vac who produce and supply antichoking devices globally. She has already donated a number of these devices to local restaurants / cafes and a local primary school. These devices have now saved almost 1500 lives in choking emergency situations. The family contacted us to say that they would love to donate one of these devices to Holy Family. We were delighted to receive the device and would like to thank the family for this very kind gesture.
