#### FREE BIKE MAINTENANCE SERVICE

Just a reminder from last week's newsletter, that we have received information that a bike mechanic can come into our school on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> March throughout the school day to have a look at any of the children's or adults' bikes and complete a free safety check. He will check over as many bikes he can within the time frame, replacing cables, brake blocks, doing minor repairs and adjustments, and

ensuring the bikes are safe to ride. If you would like your bikes to be looked at, please bring them in on the Tuesday morning and leave them with the mechanic and then pick them up at the end of the day. The mechanic will check everything on your child's or adults bike from wheels, brakes, gears and tyre pressure to lights, racks, pedals, saddles and more. By the end, your bike will feel loved and cared for. Any minor adjustments, they can make to the bike they do there and then. Anything they can't fix on site, they will let you know exactly what needs doing and a rough guide to what it should cost at a bike shop.
