

STARS ON THE DOORS



Throughout the term, classes have the chance to win gold stars for their class that are placed on classroom doors. The winning class will be the class with the most gold stars on the door and they will be given a special whole class reward.

During break and lunch times, classes have the opportunity to win silver stars. The teacher on duty will reward the best class or classes with a silver star. Silver stars can also be awarded during assemblies.

When a class wins 5 silver stars, this can be exchanged for a gold star.

Silver stars can also be won, if a class has 100% attendance each day.

Gold stars can be won for the whole class if the children have completed exceptional work, showed impeccable behaviour and/or are living out our school vision consistently. This might be seen during lessons or lunchtime.
