FOREST SCHOOL TRAINING

This week Miss Killen has been completing the final few days of her Forest school training. This has been my passion for a few years, and we have finally been able to secure funding for the training. Miss Killen will be coming back with lots of ideas and hopefully we will be able to introduce Forest School activities into our busy school curriculum too. Forest School is an inspiring outdoor learning approach that takes place in a natural setting, such as a woodland or forest area. In our school, it will offer children the opportunity to develop confidence, independence, and resilience through hands-on experiences in nature. Sessions will be child-led and play-based, allowing pupils to explore, take appropriate risks, and build important life skills in a supportive and engaging environment. Activities might include building dens, using tools safely, exploring wildlife, and working together on creative challenges. Forest School supports children's physical, emotional, and social development while deepening their connection to the natural world.
