Learning Objectives

- To differentiate between positive risk taking and dangerous behaviour and to identify occasions where they can take responsibility for their own safety.
- To learn how to deal with common injuries using basic first aid techniques and how to respond in an emergency (999).
- To know that there are laws relating to drugs common to everyday life as some drugs are legal (helpful/harmful) and some drugs are illegal.
- To explore reasons why people choose to use or not use harmful drugs, including nicotine, e-cigarettes/vaping, alcohol and medicines as well as illegal drugs and the risks and effects of different drugs.
- To know that there are organisations where people can get help and support concerning drug use.
